#### Field Trip to the Dominguez Rancho Adobe Museum (1826)

Join us for a visit and 1:00 pm tour on Sunday, October 24 of one of the oldest surviving buildings in greater Los Angeles and the oldest of the existing Spanish Land Grant buildings. This tour is of both the old and newer sections of this recently restored building, furnished appropriately for the 19th Century Mexican era (1821 - 1850, when California became a state).

Since the tour is actually at 1:00 pm and in order to take outdoor pictures before the tour (if you are so inclined), we will meet at 12:15 pm at Alpine Village at the "usual spot" at the edge of the parking area where it meets the corner gas station. It then takes about 12 minutes to get to the Museum. (North on the 110 to 91, East on the 91 to Alameda, South on Alameda 1/2 mile to gate in high wall.)

Bring your wide angle lenses for outside photos and tripod for inside photos. The grounds are very pretty and park-like. Another building facing the Adobe is more modern and was built in the 1920s (?) for the Claretian Fathers. The Dominguez sisters gave the property to this Catholic order which originated in Spain and it is their retirement home.
